**Which one of these diseases do you fear more - AIDS or malaria? Why?**

The Millennium Development Goals are eight goals for all nations in the world that United Nations established in 2000 to be achieved by 2015. The goals relate to eradication of poverty, universal primary education, women rights, environmental sustainability, and health.

The seventh goal is combating AIDS/HIV, malaria and other diseases. By 2015, everyone in the world should have access to treatment for these diseases and the number of people newly infected and the number of deaths due to AIDS or malaria should be declining.

Write FEAR followed by your answer.

If your answer is AIDS, write FEAR AIDS and explain why.

If your answer is malaria, write FEAR malaria and explain why.

Do not forget to write FEAR (F-E-A-R) so we can know what the message refers to.

The messages should be anonymous so you don't need to include any personal information on it. If you decide to write your name, your phone number and answer will be linked to it.

The answers will be sent to the University of Cambridge (CGHR) and compared with the answers sent by radio stations in other African countries. In two weeks, we will disclose what people in our community think about AIDS and malaria.
